SCORE is a developmental program that seeks to increase the research competitiveness of faculty at institutions that have a historical mission focused on serving students from underrepresented groups. Research proposed under SCORE mechanisms SC1, SC2 or SC3 must fall within the scope of the NIH mission. http://www.nih.gov/about/mission.htm. The next deadline is **Thursday, January 25, 2018**.

ALERT WHY THIS ALERT? This publication has been created to serve the purpose of informing researchers of new information, trends and concerns as they occur.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Only full-time tenure-track faculty are eligible.
- PIs with a current federal or non-federal investigator research awards are not eligible.
- PIs who have current research support provided as part of the RCMI grant or equivalent cooperative agreements (i.e., Weill Cornell CTSC) are not eligible.
- You cannot be PI on any other research project (federal or non-federal) if and when the award is made.
- No foreign collaborators.
- No international work or research components.
- Consortium agreements are only allowed with SCORE eligible institutions.
- Collaborators, secretarial or clerical support cannot be paid.
