MINORITY-SERVING INSTITUTION (MSI) STATUS UPDATE

The Minority Serving Institution (MSI) classification enables institutions to improve and expand their capacity to serve specific populations. Several funding agencies give priority to MSI institutions. There are eight federally designated Minority Serving Institution (MSI) classifications for institutions of higher education. These classifications are:

Alaska Native-Serving Institutions

Asian American Native American Pacific Islander-Serving Institutions**

Historically Black Colleges & Universities

Hispanic Serving Institutions**

Native American-Serving Non-Tribal Institutions

Native Hawaiian-Serving Institutions

Predominantly Black Institutions

Tribal Colleges and Universities

- Hunter College meets the criteria for the following programs:
 - Title III - Part A - Asian American and Native American Pacific Islander-Serving Institutions (AANAPISI)
 - Title III - Part A - Strengthening Institutions (SIP)
 - Title III - Part F - Asian American and Native American Pacific Islander-Serving Institutions (AANAPISI)
 - Title V - Developing Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSI)
 - Title V - Promoting Postbaccalaureate Opportunities for Hispanic Americans (PPOHA)
