#### Opening Remarks

The improved environment for research and sponsored programs at Hunter College over the past decade produced its most tangible results in our most recently concluded fiscal year. Renowned throughout its ll6-year history as an institution of higher learning primarily dedicated to imparting a quality liberal arts education to New York City's youth, the College has made major inroads into a wide range of research areas.

With a handful of Hunter faculty who sought outside support for their research in the 1960's, the College could manage to allocate only minimal resources to shaping a research-oriented climate. Resources were further stretched by the commitment of the 1970's to open admissions and, later, by the fiscal crisis faced by the City of New York.

Building on the strengths of the faculty, the College began to encourage other faculty and staff to seek external funding in a more organized manner. In 1983 a major obstacle to housing sponsored programs with their additional space requirements was removed with the opening of Hunter College's East and West Buildings at the 68th Street Campus. The long-awaited structures allowed faculty and staff the room needed to take on additional commitments and enabled the College to institute a phased renovation of existing facilities. This foregoing brief sketch of recent events gives the reader some background on the process involved in bringing to Hunter College a reputation as a major resource in the educational and research communities.

We are pleased to report that 177 awards totalling \$10,751,915 were made to Hunter College in fiscal 1986, eclipsing last year's record dollar total by 32%. Funding for research increased 46% from the previous year. Overall, the College showed increased strength in all areas of grant support. We are pleased to extend our congratulations to the members of our faculty and staff who led Hunter College to its most successful year in grants and contracts.

As the document that follows is meant primarily for internal consumption, we think you will be interested in the trends that are evident and in the individual project breakdown. The information in this report was compiled by the staff of the Office of Research Administration:

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#### REPORT OF GRANTS AND CONTRACTS - FISCAL YEAR 1986

This report covers the period from July 1, 1985 through June 30, 1986, the most successful period for grants and contracts in Hunter College's history.

One of the most revealing indicators of the growth of grants and contracts at Hunter over the past decade has been the number of individual faculty and staff applicants. There were 57 applicants who submitted 82 proposals in fiscal year (FY) 1977, and these numbers have grown to 154 applicants filing 303 proposals in FY 1986.

Throughout this report, comparisons are made to statistical data gathered over the past decade. A great many new annual records were established in FY 1986, and the percentage of increase as compared to a decade ago is shown for those categories below:

#### Section I-A: OVERVIEW OF EXTERNAL FUNDING







## CLASSIFICATION OF AWARDS BY PURPOSE PERCENTAGE OF AMOUNT AWARDED - FY1986





#### Section I-B: INDIVIDUAL PROJECT LISTING

This section's 37 pages list the individual projects that comprised the year's record of awards sponsored by external sources in fiscal year 1986. Also included are grants made directly to individuals (e.g., fellowships), but these figures are not included in the overall statistics on institutionally administered awards shown in the previous section. In several cases, Hunter faculty have coprincipal investigators at other institutions. When fiscal responsibility for an award lies with a colleagues's institution, CUNY collaborations are counted in the dollar total, and non-CUNY administered awards are listed but not counted.

Awards are arranged alphabetically by academic administrative regions. Within that framework, awards are organized first by department and then by faculty member. Entries include the name of the funding agency, and when applicable, the agency identification number and remarks. Among other data shown are the Research Foundation account number, the award period, and, of course, the amount awarded. "Type" indicates whether the award is new, a continuation (non-competitive but contingent on sufficient progress having been demonstrated to warrant continued funding), a renewal (after competitive review of an ongoing project), or a supplement (additional funding to complete or only slightly extend the scope of the original project). When applicable, the "status" gives the length of the project in years and whether the agency has indicated its intention to continue funding on a non-competitive basis beyond the current period.







Applicants may request a maximum of \$12,000 for research support. The seventeenth annual competition was held during fiscal year 1986, and Hunter faculty members had their most successful year, both in number of awards and grant dollars.

#### Overall Summary of Project Support

At the conclusion of this report, we present statistical tables incorporating all the award data available for the last ten years. This shows the growth of project support over the past decade. In each year, the dollar volume of the previous year was surpassed. In all but one year, in which the prior year's tally of awards was matched, the total number of awards rose as compared to the preceding year. As will be seen, the numbers and amounts of the awards have more than tripled over the ten-year period.

The Office of Research Administration embarked on a campaign of retrieving information from faculty members who have had awards not handled by the CUNY Research Foundation or Hunter College. The data gathered over the last twelve months have been included in the appropriate years, and the tables in Part III of this report reflect the updated information back to the beginning of fiscal year 1977.


