As we conclude one very difficult year and begin another, a source of great satisfaction is the commitment of Hunter College's faculty and staff to research and to gaining support for sponsored projects.

Although we are going through a very difficult period in the history of the College, Hunter's talent continues to shine forth. Award volume rose for the eleventh consecutive year, setting a new mark at \$26.8 million.

Strength was exhibited in all areas of the College, with two divisions, one school, and two centers reaching their highest level ever. High on the list of achievements is the more than \$1 million included in awards for student fellowships, scholarships, and internships, not to mention more than 300 jobs provided for students who are gaining hands-on experience in laboratories and offices.

I take great pride in the accomplishments of everyone in the Hunter community, and I am pleased to congratulate everyone who participated in Hunter's record setting year.

A Note from the Director

Hunter College faculty and staff submit grant proposals to a variety of agencies. Among the many initiatives are collaborations with other universities and non-profit organizations.

Earlier this summer, a consortium partner asked us to demonstrate our "corporate capability" by providing various information and documents, including evidence of Hunter's ability to produce publications. The consortium leadership was not looking for books or articles authored by members of Hunter's faculty, but rather for publications that were the result of "team work." Never having collected such items in any organized way, I immediately made calls to several of Hunter's centers and to the Publications Office.

Within hours, we had a wide array of publications, including:

- ◆ *Books, brochures, and mailers developed by the Brookdale Center on Aging*
- ◆ *The widely acknowledged Bulletin published several times a year by El Centro de Estudios Puertorriquenos*
- ◆ *An environmental health newsletter prepared for a union by the Center for Occupational and Environmental Health*
- ◆ *Copies of a seasonal research publication from the Institute for the Study of Gene Structure and Function*
- ◆ *Various publications disseminated by the Center for AIDS, Drugs and Community Health*
- ◆ *The College's catalogs, recruiting brochures, alumni newspaper and a multitude of other items prepared by the Office of Institutional Advancement in conjunction with numerous departments.*

The impressive collection was express mailed to the consortium's primary applicant for inclusion as back-up materials for a major grant proposal. While it will be several months before we learn whether the application proves successful, the documents clearly showed how diverse and talented an institution we are.

The publication you are holding gives many statistics heralding the growth of Hunter's grant volume over the last two decades. The staff of the Office of Research Administration is pleased to provide this report. The success in grants is a point of pride in this 125th anniversary year.

Section I-A

OVERVIEW OF EXTERNAL FUNDING

This section contains statistical information on grants and contracts from external sources, i.e., agencies of Federal, State, and City governments, foundations, corporations, and non-profit organizations. For the sake of making comparisons, figures are given beginning July 1, 1970.

Grants and contracts have undergone remarkable growth since the late 1970's. Viewing awards in ten-year increments, we used 1975 as the initial base year to illustrate growth:

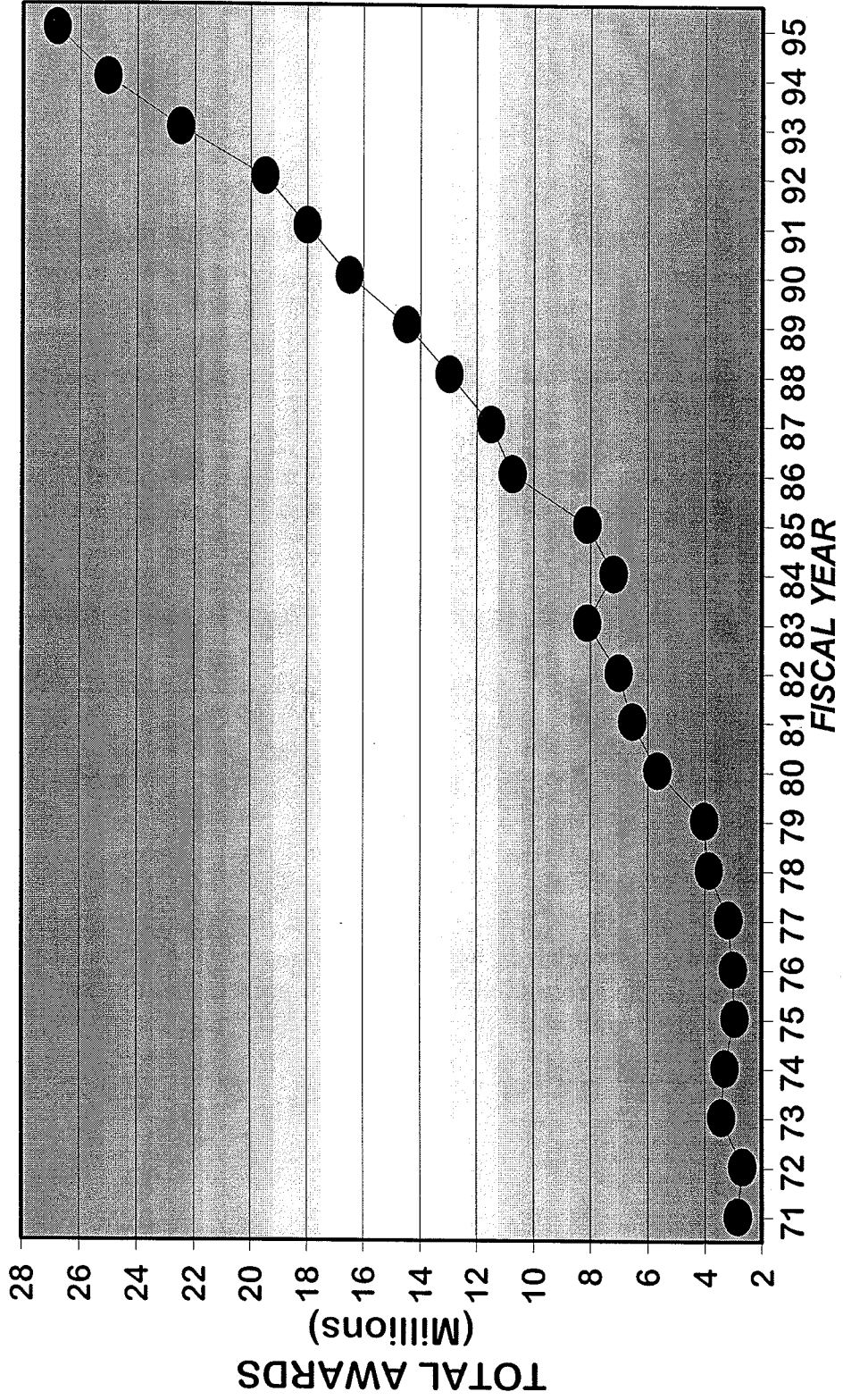

The "mix" of the source of grants has also undergone tremendous change. In 1975, Federal grants totaled \$2.2 million and represented 74% of that year's grants. In 1995, Federal grants rose to more than \$11.4 million, but that amount constituted only 43% of our \$26.8 million.

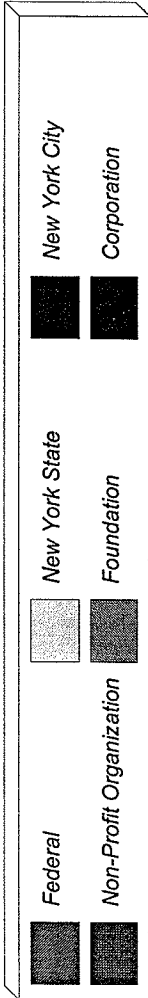
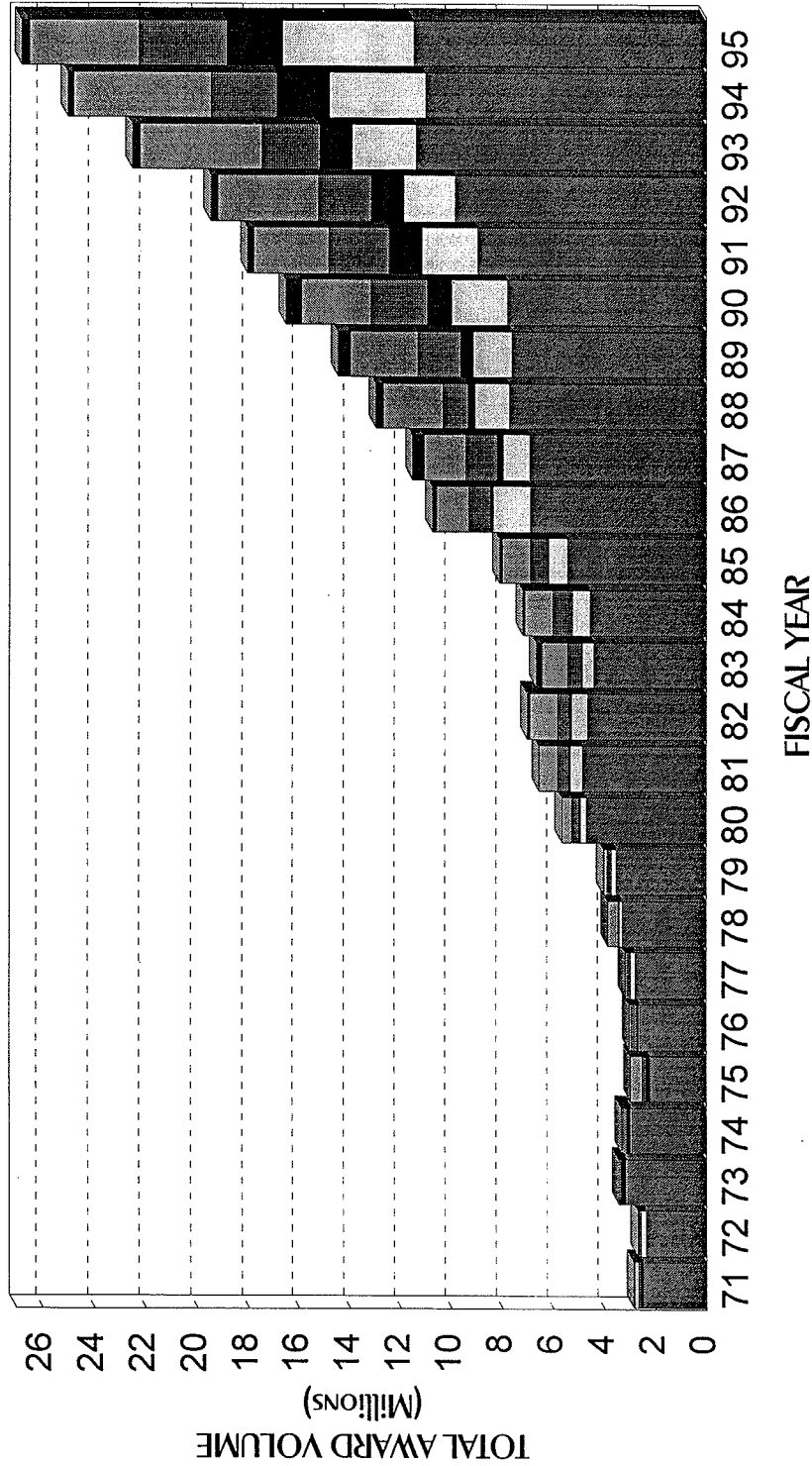

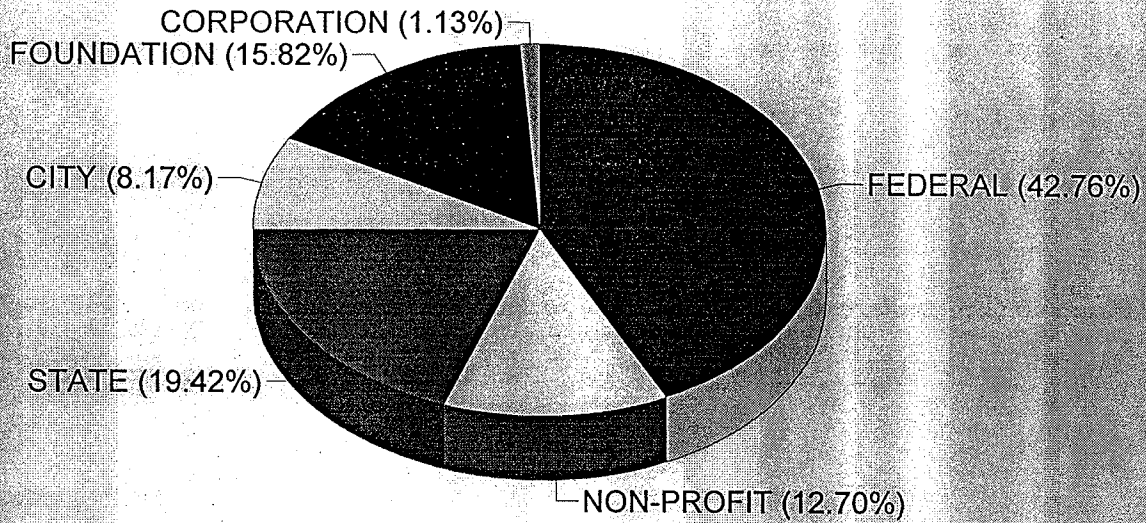

AWARDS RECEIVED IN 1995 BY SOURCE

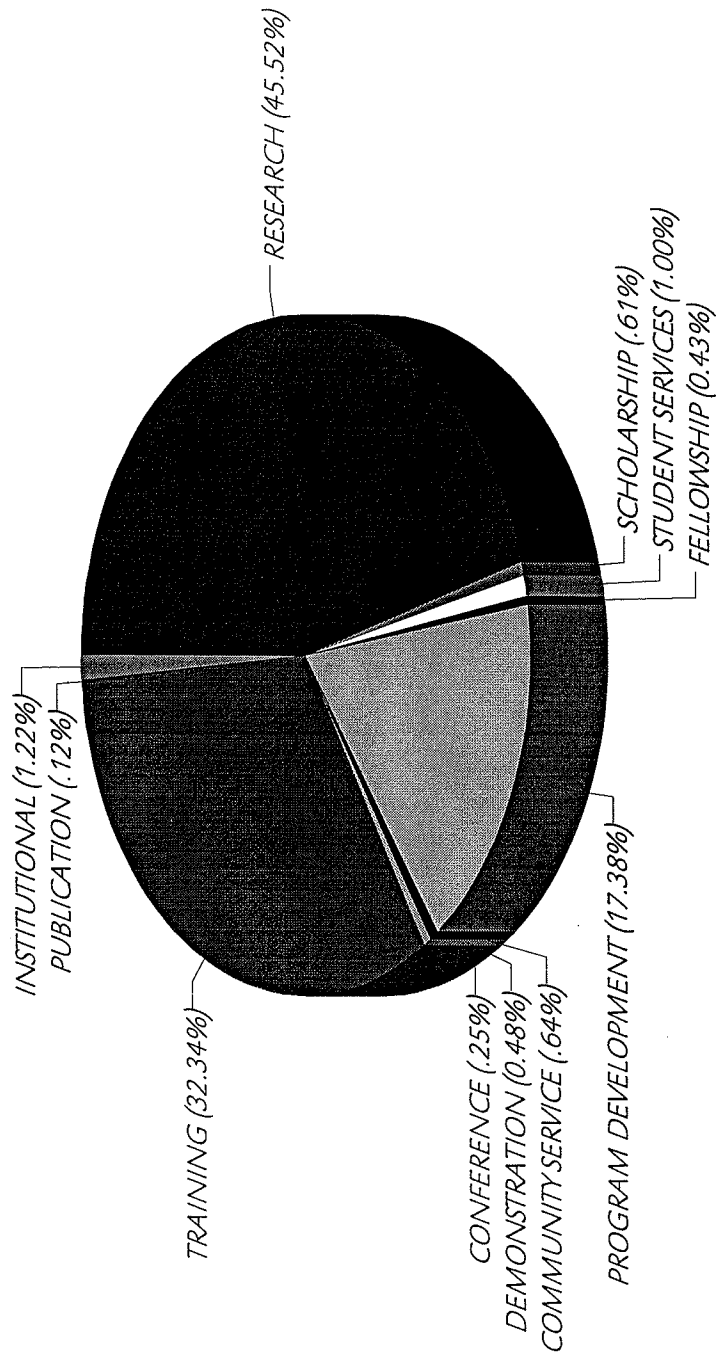

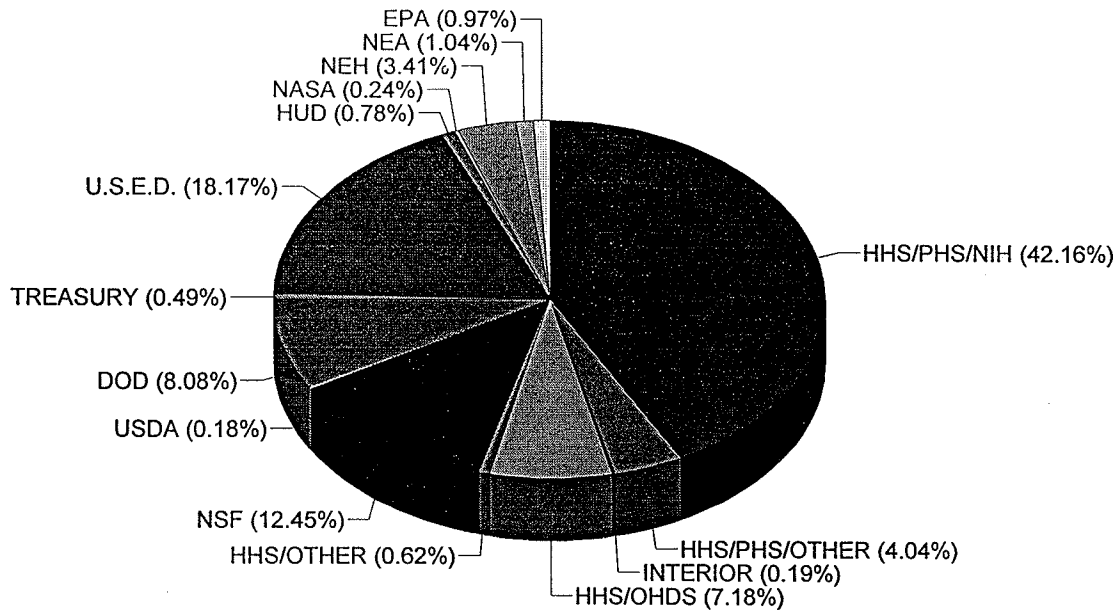

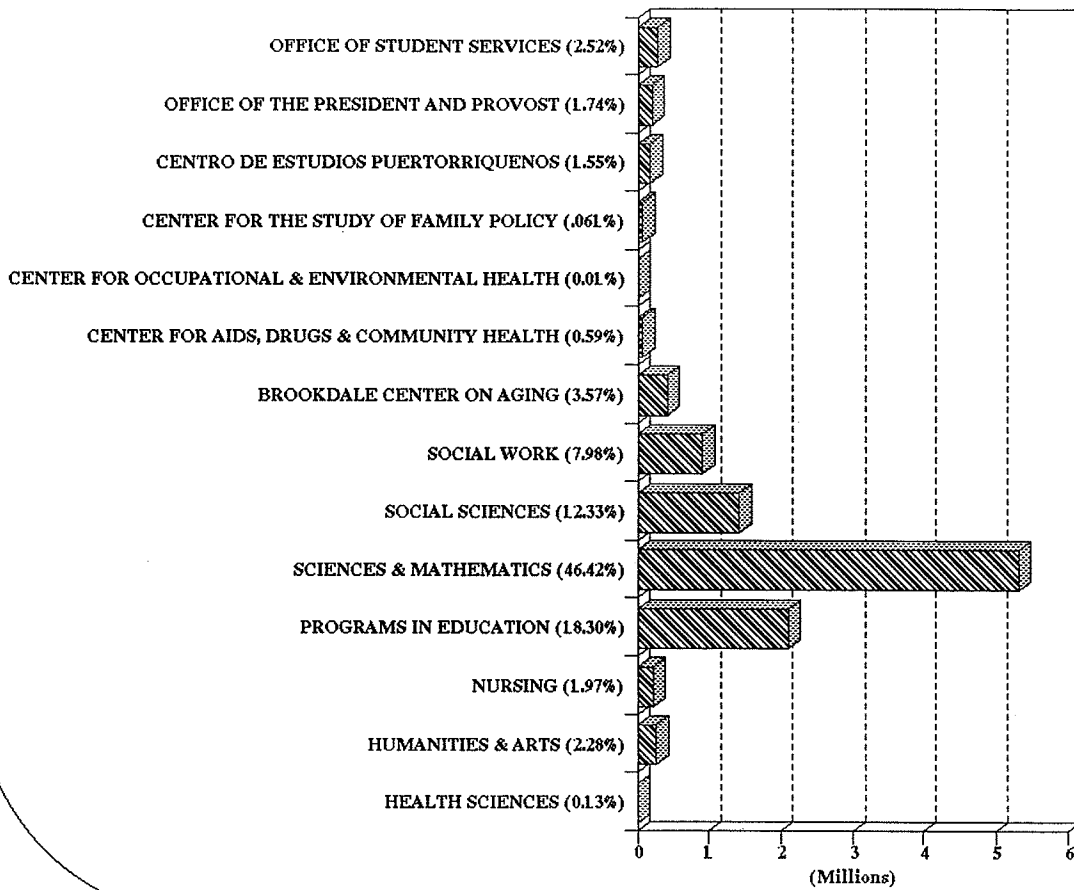
BREAKDOWN OF FEDERAL SUPPORT

FEDERAL SUPPORT TO DIVISIONS, SCHOOLS, AND PROGRAMS - FISCAL YEAR 1995

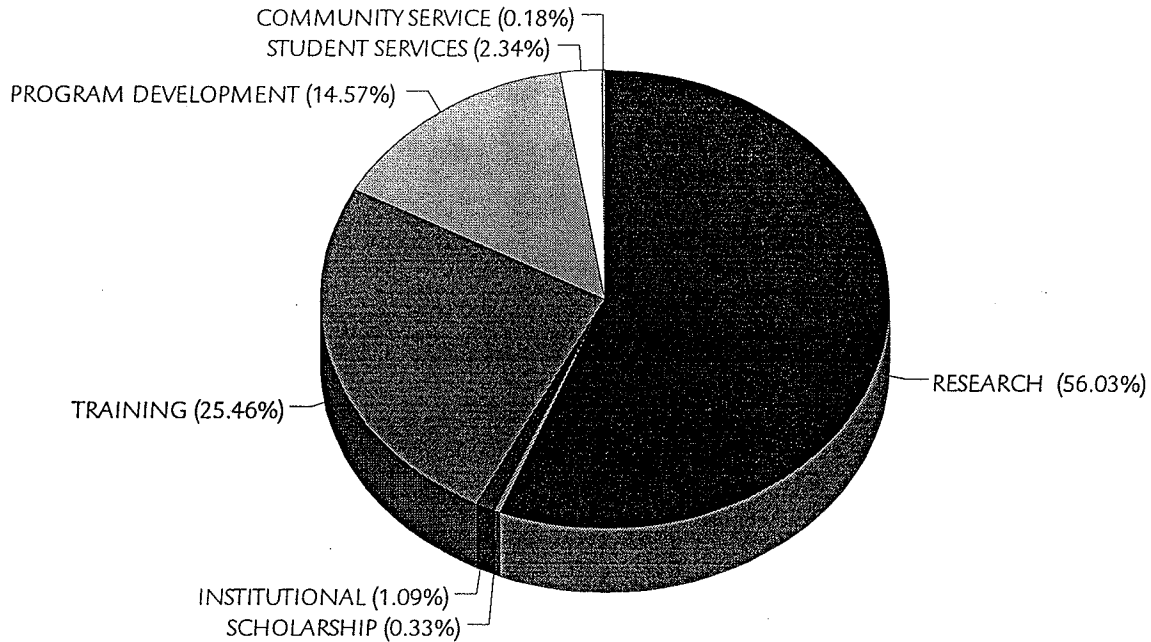

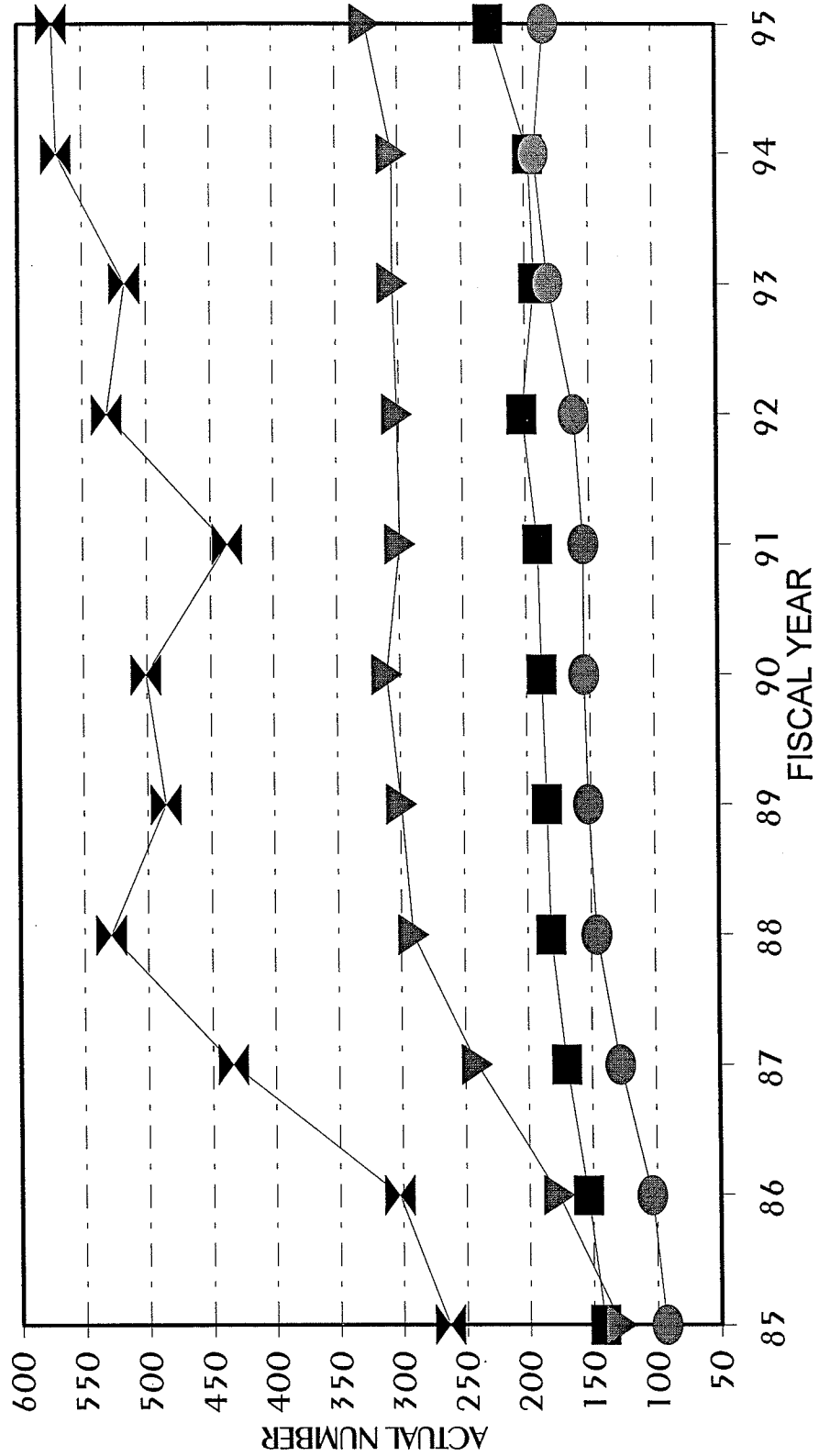

PSC-CUNY RESEARCH AWARD PROGRAM

The Board of Trustees of the City University of New York (CUNY) and the collective bargaining agent for the instructional staff, the Professional Staff Congress (PSC), demonstrate their recognition of the importance of encouraging research activities in the CUNY system by funding a competitive research award program. Applicants may request a maximum of \$12,000 for research support.

In the 26 years of the PSC-CUNY Research Award Program, Hunter College faculty and staff have been awarded more than \$8.2 million. Grants are designed to encourage research and serve as pilot projects and seed money for larger endeavors.

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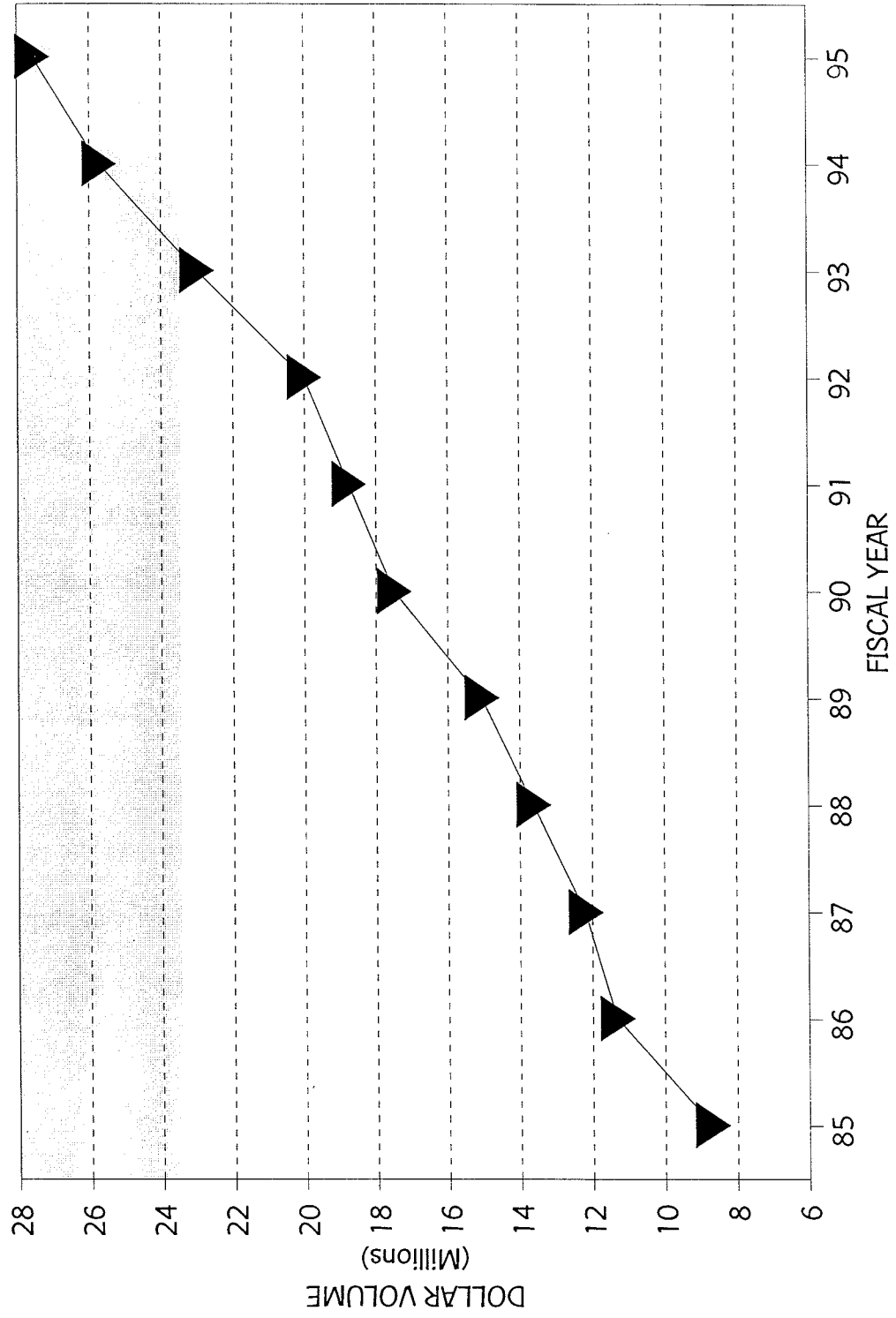
Overall Summary of Project Support

At the conclusion of this report, we present statistical tables incorporating all the award data available for the last quarter century. The information in this section includes the external awards detailed in Section I-A and I-B of this report, plus fellowships and other grants awarded directly to faculty, the PSC-CUNY Research Award Program (Section II-A) and other internal support (Section II-B). The intent here is to present as broad a picture as possible of the support obtained by faculty and staff.

This section shows a steady growth of project support over the past decade. For twenty consecutive years the dollar volume of the previous year was surpassed. As will be seen the numbers and amounts of the awards have risen by 217% during the last decade, and 759% over the last two decades.


